Essential Qualifications for the post of Assistant Professor:

1. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST/Persons with Disability vis. physically and visually disabled or those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19.09.1991 and hold a Ph.D. degree) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.
2. Candidates must have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC (state level eligibility test-SLET/SET).

General Note:

1. Candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
2. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Degree Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.
3. The candidates applying under PwD category may specifically mention in application their main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.
4. The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 29.12.2005. The format is available at the website www.persmin.nic.in
5. The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
6. The College reserves its right not to fill any or all the post(s) advertised.
7. Application form may be obtained from the office of the College from 10:00 A.M. to 05:00 P.M. on or before the last date of submission either in person or by sending a self addressed and stamped envelope of 12x9 size. **Application form is also available on the <http://dcac.du.ac.in>.**
8. Separate applications have to be submitted for each post.

10. Merely fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions does not entitle the candidates to be called for interview. The applications received shall be screened in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the University in this regard, to restrict the no. of candidates.
