## 1. College Website

The website is dynamic and is constantly being updated. The Website Design and Automation Committee, constituted by the College Staff Council, overlooks the maintenance and upgradation of the website.

### 2. Administration

The College uses advanced Excel to maintain databases. Members of the administrative staff undergo training to upgrade their skill.

a. CCTV Surveillance

The college has installed CCTV cameras at various strategic locations. Recording of CCTV is maintained and stored for one week.

### 3. Admission

The College follows University guidelines in the admission process. This process totally online and all relevant information is displayed on the college website (<u>https://dcac.du.ac.in/</u>). The College prospectus, containing all relevant information for students and guardians, is hosted on the website.

#### 4. Accounts and Finance

Tally software is used by the accounts office to maintain financial records. The College funnels all financial transactions through the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) in line with Government of India guidelines. All payments are made through NEFT/online.
