- No fees for publication or open access; all articles appear on the DCAC website.
- December 2025 issue will be released by the end of Q1 2026.
- No withdrawals allowed once a manuscript is approved by the Chief Editor and sent for review.

- •12-pt Times New Roman, double-spaced
- •APA referencing; embed and consecutively cite all figures, tables, and images (tables with titles and units)
- •Superscript-numbered references, listed in order at the end

Terms & Conditions

- Original work, not under review elsewhere; multiple submissions prohibited.
- Plagiarism leads to immediate rejection.
- Acknowledgments (if any) go before References.
- Copyright remains with authors; views expressed are authors' own.
