CONSTITUTION OF STUDENTS' COUNCIL  
DELHI COLLEGE OF ARTS & COMMERCE

1. Students' Council will be known as Delhi College of Arts & Commerce Students Council, hereinafter referred to as 'Council'.
2. The main objective of the students' Council will be to organise cultural, educational, sport's activities in the college and also to co-operate towards the solution of day-to-day problems and the difficulties faced by the students and create healthy atmosphere for all round development of the students of the College.
3. The Council will consist of the following elected office bearers:
  1. President
  2. General Secretary
  3. Vice-President
  4. Sports Secretary
  5. Cultural Secretary
  6. Joint Secretary
  7. Secretary Girls Common Room

In addition of these office bearers one representative from each course will be elected by the students of the respective course.

4. Eligibility for election to Council

- (a) President: Only third year student will be eligible to seek election to the office of President.
- (b) Vice-President: No Ist year student can contest election to the office of the Vice-President.
- (c) Sports Secretary: The student seeking election to this post should be a good sportsman having excellence in sports.
- (d) Cultural Secretary: The student seeking election to this post should have outstanding achievement in cultural activities (like music, singing, debate).

5. Election

- (i) Election to these office bearers will be held in August and exact date will be declared by Staff Council/Patron.
- (ii) The term of the office bearers and other representatives will be from August to 1st April every year. However, in case any member of the Council is found guilty of indiscipline expelled, fined or involved in any criminal case or caught for using unfair means in any examination will cease to be the member from the day the action is taken against him/her.
- (iii) Principal of the college will be the Patron of the Students' Council.
- (iv) Patron can suspend any member including President from the office, if he is satisfied that the continuance of such member in his post is detrimental to the interest of the college or the Council. Such member/President will be removed by the Patron (Principal in Council) after giving him due opportunity.

6. General Eligibility Conditions.

- (i) No student who has been expelled, fined, failed in examination (including those who failed in 1st year of Honours Courses), detailed/debarred by the authorities from taking examination for any reason, dropouts, involved in using unfair means in the examination, will be eligible to seek election or caste vote.
- (ii) No student against whom disciplinary action has been taken by the college shall be eligible to caste vote or seek election.
- (iii) No student who is involved in any criminal case and against whom such case is pending in any court shall be eligible to seek election or caste his vote.
- (iv) Issuing of posters, banners, cards, pamphlets, writing on the wall, shouting of slogans
