The Chairperson welcomed all the members of the Faculty of Commerce and Business, and appreciated the efforts of all the faculty members of the Department of Commerce as well as Colleges for giving valuable inputs in formulating the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework- 2022 based on National Education Policy- 2020 for B. Com. (Hons.), B. Com. and BA Commerce based Courses. The Chairperson welcomed the new members and thanked the outgoing members for their contribution during their tenure as an esteemed member of the Faculty of Commerce and Business.

Following decisions were taken unanimously:

#### 1. Confirmation of the minutes of previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 were placed in the meeting and were unanimously confirmed by the house.

# 2. Revision of courses according to Undergraduate Curriculum Framework- 2022 based on National Education Policy- 2020 for B. Com. (Hons.), B. Com. and BA Commerce Based Courses

The Chairperson apprised the House about the structure and syllabi of courses for B. Com. (Hons.), B. Com. and BA Commerce Based Courses. The following suggestions were given by the House for further consideration:

- E-Filing of Returns should be added as a practical component in the syllabi of Income Tax (Core Course) in B. Com. (Hons.) and B. Com.
- ii. The nomenclature of Economics courses (Core) should be changed in order to avoid any ambiguity with respect to courses offered by the Department of

- Economics as well as smooth examination process. It was also resolved that there should be special mention that all the courses mentioned in these programmes will be taught by the Faculty members of the Department of Commerce.
- iii. The practical component should be increased in each paper as far as possible in order to make it more contemporary and skill based. For such courses, tutorials should be converted into practicals with one credit which would require two hours of practical work.

- 3. The House unanimously approved the revised courses of B. Com. (Hons.), B. Com. and BA Commerce based Courses for onward submission to the University for further approval. The Chairperson was also authorised to make appropriate changes based on the stakeholders' feedback through Google Form which should be made available on the website: www.commerce.du.ac.in.

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#### 17.0 उद्देश्य

#### 17.1 प्रस्तावना

हिंदी साहित्य में प्रसादोत्तर नाटक में एकांकी नाटक विधा के प्रसार का विशेष महत्व है। एकांकी की लोकप्रियता का कारण यह था कि सीमित साधन और समय में नाटक को सफलतापूर्वक मंचित किया जा सकता था। विश्वविद्यालय और महाविद्यालय के सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम में एकांकी प्रस्तुति अनिवार्य हिस्सा हुआ करता था। इससे युवा छात्रों के बीच रंगमंच का संपर्क बना रहा और रंग गतिविधि में सक्रिय रहे। ऐसे समय में 'दीपदान' एकांकी की रचना हुई थी। हिंदी का रंगमंच का आकार सुस्पष्ट और धुंधला था। पारसी थियेटर और पृथ्वी थियेटर लगभग बंद हो चुके थे, रंग संस्था का निर्माण अभी हुआ नहीं था। ऐसे में रंगमंचीय सिक्रयता को एकांकी ने जीवित रखा। यह एकांकी का रंगमंच के इतिहास में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान है। एकांकी के विकास का दूसरा कारण रेडियों से जुड़ा है। रेडियो का प्रचलन बढ़ने से उस पर अनेक कार्यक्रमों का प्रसारण होने लगा उसी क्रम में रेडियो पर नाटक प्रसारित किए जाने लगे। लंबे नाटक को उस में प्रसारित करना कठिन था। एकांकी को सुविधापूर्वक प्रसारित किया

हिंदी के एकांकीकार में डॉ. रामकुमार वर्मा का महत्व का अंदाजा इसी से लगाया जा सकता है कि उनके जन्म दिन को एकांकी दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाने लगा। उन्होंने 114 एकांकी की रचना की। दीपदान (1953) उनकी एक महत्वपूर्ण एकांकी है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी मध्यकालीन भारतीय इतिहास के एक विशेष कालखंड की घटना पर आधारित है। इसका संबंध चित्तौड़ के इतिहास से है। चित्तौड़ के इतिहास की अनेक घटनाएँ जनमानस में प्रतिष्ठित हैं। इसी क्रम में एक नाम पन्ना घाय का भी है। पन्ना ने महाराणा वंश को सुरक्षित रखने के लिए अपने पुत्र का बलिदान किया था। उसका नाम वहाँ जनश्रुति में अमिट है।

दीपदान एक यथार्थवादी शैली का एकांकी नाटक है। यह अवधारणा पश्चिमी नाटकों की देन है। हिंदी में इस शैली के नाटकों का प्रचलन चौथे दशक से माना जा सकता है। वास्तव में इस शैली के नाटकों में अन्विति को व्यापक महत्व दिया गया है। स्थान, समय और कार्य की अन्विति का संकलन उसकी संरचना का आधार है।

स्थान, समय और कार्य को एकांकी के माध्यम से समझने की जरूरत है। स्थान किसी भी प्रकार के नाटक की पहली और बुनियादी जरूरत है। चूँकि स्थान के मुताबिक नाटक की दृश्य योजना की रचना की जाती है। स्थान ऐसा निश्चित किया जाता है जिसे मंच पर दिखाया जा सके। उदाहरण के रूप में 'दीपदान' एकांकी में राजभवन का एक कक्ष रखा गया है। इस कक्ष को सहजता से दृश्य के रूप में दिखाया जा सकता है। इसी प्रकार समय रात्रि के दूसरे प्रहर का है। समय निश्चित हो जाने से प्रकाश व्यवस्था को निश्चित किया जा सकता है। क्योंकि दिन में प्रकाश और उजाला होता है। रात्रि में अंधेरा होता है। रात्रि के अंधकार में गुप्त कार्य को अंजाम देना आसान होता है। सिंहासन के लिए षड्यंत्र को प्रतिफलित करना इस एकांकी का कार्यकलाप है। ये तीनों एक दूसरे से जुड़े हुए हैं। इसी को अन्वित कहा गया है।

'दीपदान' एकांकी का कथानक ऐतिहासिक है। इतिहास में पन्ना धाय के त्याग की कहानी अंकित है। उसी घटना को आधार बनाकर एकांकीकार ने एकांकी का ताना बाना बुना है। इतिहास की घटना को एकांकी संरचना में प्रस्तुत करना चुनौतीपूर्ण होता है। एकांकी की संरचना खासकर यथार्थवादी शैली में समकालीनता का आग्रह अधिक होता होता है। इतिहास की कथावस्तु और समकालीनता को पिरोना और उसमें नाट्यानुभूति को सुरक्षित रखना इतना आसान नहीं होता है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी में एकांकीकार ने मध्यकालीन इतिहास की कथावस्तु में राष्ट्रप्रेम की भावना को सम्मिश्रित करके उसे प्रासंगिक बना दिया है।

#### 17.2 कथावस्तु

एकांकी नाटक में कथावस्तु के आधार पौराणिक ऐतिहासिक और समकालीन जीवन से ग्रहण किए जाते रहे हैं। 'दीपदान' एकांकी की कथावस्तु मध्यकालीन चित्तौड़ के इतिहास से ली गई है। इतिहास में चित्तौड़ का स्मरण त्याग और बिलदान के लिए किया जाता रहा है। वहाँ के शासक की निष्ठा और देशभिक्त को आदर्श माना जाता रहा है। उाँ. रामकुमार वर्मा ने इसी आदर्श को ध्यान में रखकर 'दीपदान' एकांकी के कथ्य को बुना है। इस एकांकी में जहाँ घटनाएँ इतिहास के द्वारा निर्देशित हैं वहीं पात्र के मनोभाव और वातावरण एकांकीकार की कल्पना से परिचालित हैं। इसलिए इस एकांकी में जीवन के उज्जवल पक्ष त्याग बिलदान गौरव के साथ—साथ षड्यंत्र कुचक्र, विश्वासघात और महत्वाकांक्षा से कथावृत्त मेरा पड़ा है। सामंती जीवन में सत्ता की भूख

में कोई कितना अंधा और विवेक शून्य हो सकता है। उसका जीता जागता उदाहरण इस एकांकी का पात्र बनवीर है।

कथा का आंरम चित्तीड़ के महल के एक कक्ष में होता है। महाराणा साँगा का छोटा पुत्र कुँवर उदय सिंह अपनी धाय माँ पन्ना से बातचीत कर रहा है। सामंतशाही में शासन वंश परंपरा के अनुसार चलती थी। चित्तौड़ पर महाराणा वंश का शासन था। उन्हीं के उत्तराधिकारी को वहाँ शासन करने की वैधता प्राप्त थी। यह व्यवस्था उस स्थान की जनता के द्वारा समर्पित थी। वंश की परंपरा पर पन्ना की टिप्पणी है "दिन में तो तुम चित्तौड़ के सूरज हो कुँवर और रात में तुम राजवंश के दीपक हो।" चूँिक महाराणा वंश का एकमात्र चिराग कुँवर उदय सिंह जीवित है, वह अमीर बालक है, षड्यंत्रकारी उसकी हत्या करके राज हड़पने के लिए प्रयासरत है। कुचक्र रचने का अभियान कोई दूसरा नहीं अपनी वंश के एक दासी पुत्र बनवीर के द्वारा ही की जाती है। पन्ना धाय उस परिस्थित को समझती है। वह अपनी योजना के अनुसार कार्य करती है।

राजवंश में दीपदान उत्सव का आयोजन है। उत्सव धार्मिक परंपरा के अनुसार और मनोरंजन के लिए होता है। लेकिन इस एकांकी में षड्यंत्र को सफल बनाने के लिए किया जा रहा है। दीपदान प्रकाश का उत्सव है लेकिन अँधेरी शक्तियों, रस, रंग और नृत्य का भुलावा देर कुटिल मनोभाव को प्रतिफलित करना चाहते हैं। मनोरंजन में जनता को यथार्थ से दूर रखने प्रयास चल रहा है। पन्ना धाय इस उत्सव से अलग है, उसके मन में अनहोनी घटना की आशंका है। विषम परिस्थिति आने की पूर्वसूचना उसके अन्तःकरण में गतिशील है। सोना के लाख कहने बाद भी पन्ना, कुँवर उदय सिंह को उसे मिलने नहीं देती। वह धाय माँ, संरक्षिका है इसलिए वह अपने कर्त्तव्य को भली भाँति समझती है।

कथा के विकास के क्रम में सामली जो अंतःपुर की परिचारिका है, उसका प्रवेश होता है। अंतःपुर की गतिविधि को सामली अच्छी तरह समझती है। उसकी सूचना से कथानक में गति आ जाती है। नाटक की कथावस्तु में कौतुहलता और जिज्ञासा का भाव पैदा हो जाता है। अब आगे नाटक में क्या होने वाला है— इस दिलचरपी से दर्शक भर जाता है। अब आगे नाटक में क्या होने वाला है— इस दिलचरपी से दर्शक भर जाता है। सामली पन्ना को सूचित करती है कि बनवीर ने कुँवर उदयसिंह के बड़े भाई विक्रमादित्य की हत्या कर दी है। अब वह अपने मार्ग से कुँवर उदयसिंह को हटाकर चित्तौड़ का शासक बनना चाहता है। अब उदय सिंह का प्राण संकट में है। महल के चारों तरफ सैनिकों का पहरा है। सैनिक बनवीर के वफादार हैं। वास्तव में सामंती शासन में शक्तिशाली सरदार के पक्ष में ही सैनिक हो जाते थे। सैनिक सरदार ही सत्ता का संतुलन बनाते और बिगाड़ते थे। सत्ता की संरचना में विश्वासी गुट, असंतुष्ट गुट, नए और पुराने सभी का ताल मेल होता है। बनवीर असंतुष्ट गुट को अपने साथ लेता है, अपनी शक्ति बढ़ाता है और फिर सिंहासन के लिए चुनौती बन जाता है।

महल के रक्षक भी बनवीर के ही पक्ष में है। यहाँ कीरत नाम का एक पात्र का प्रवेश होता है। वह पन्ना धाय का विश्वास पात्र है। वह अपनी जान की बाजी लगाकर भी कुँवर उदय सिंह की रक्षा के लिए तत्पर होता है। इस कथानक में नाटकीयता यह है कि जिसने राज्य के संसाधनों का उपयोग किया और संपूर्ण सुख सुविधाओं का लाभ उठाया उसमें दायित्व बोध नहीं है। एक जूठी पत्तल उठाने वाला पात्र सत्य और न्याय के पक्ष में खड़ा होता है। पन्ना धाय कीरत को विश्वास में लेकर पत्तल की टोकरी में कुँवर उदय सिंह को लिटाकर महल से निकालने की योजना बनाती है। पन्ना धाय, दूसरी योजना कुँवर उदय सिंह की शैय्या पर अपने पुत्र चंदन को सुलाने की बनाती है। इस योजना के बिना कुँवर उदय सिंह को सुरक्षित नहीं किया जा सकता था। वह एक कठोर निर्णय लेती है। हृदय पर पत्थर रखकर अपने ही पुत्र चंदन का बलिदान देती है। वह अपने पुत्र के रक्त से महाराजा वंश को सींचती है। इस प्रसंग में माँ और बालक के वात्सल्यपूर्ण दृश्य अत्यंत मोहक हैं।

'दीपदान' का विश्लेषण और मूल्यांकन

कथानक के अंत में एकांकी का खलनायक बनवीर मंच पर उपस्थित होता है। पन्ना के त्याग और बनवीर के स्वार्थ के बीच टकराहट उपस्थित होता है। पन्ना बनवीर को धिक्कारती है। उसे चित्तौड़ की वीरता और साहस का रमरण कराती है। बनवीर सत्ता पाने की होड़ में सब कुछ भूल चुका है। वह पहले पन्ना से सौदा करना चाहता है। बात बिगड़ती देख उसे डराने की कोशिश करता है। एकांकी के अंत में वह सूचित करता है कि महाराणा विक्रमादित्य की हत्या कर चुका है और अब उदय सिंह की हत्या कर निष्कंटक राज्य भोगना उसके जीवन का लक्ष्य है। पन्ना अंत तक उसे महाराणा बनवीर नहीं हत्यारा बनवीर ही संबोधित करती है। इसी बिन्दु पर एकांकी का अंत होता है। किसी भी एकांकी अथवा नाटक के कथानक को समझने के लिए कथाक्रम का प्रवाह और घटना की शृंखला के बीच के गत्यात्मक संबंध को परखना होता है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी में एक ही कथा का विकास दिखाया गया है- पन्ना धाय के द्वारा कुँवर उदय सिंह की रक्षा की जिम्मेदारी का। इसमें घटना से घटना के बीच की एकसूत्रता और संयोजन से कथा की गति में प्रवाह बना रहता है। दीपदान का उत्सव है उसमें महाराणा परिवार के सभी सदस्य शामिल होते हैं। दीपदान की इसी घटना से अन्य घटनाएँ यथा सोना का नृत्य, दीपदान के उत्सव में षड्यंत्र, सामली द्वारा बनवारी के षड्यंत्र को उद्घाटित करना, कीरत बारी के द्वारा कुँवर उदय सिंह की रक्षा की शपथ और पन्ना धाय के द्वारा स्थिति को नियंत्रित करना आदि जुड़े हुए हैं। कथानक में दूसरी बात जो ध्यान खींचती है, वह है पन्ना धाय और कीरत बारी का प्रसंग। कथानक में केवल इतिहास हो और उसका समकालीन जीवन से कुछ भी लेना देना न हो तो ऐसे एकाकी इतिहास की पुनरावृत्ति मात्र होते हैं। 'दीपदान' एकांकी में पन्ना धाय स्त्री पात्र है और कीरत बारी समाज में हाशिए पर जीने वाला सामान्य व्यक्ति है। इन दोनों के माध्यम से एकांकीकार ने कथानक को समकालीन प्रासंगिकता से जोड़ा है। स्त्री पात्र पन्ना धाय राजवंश की नहीं है। फिर भी उसमें साहस त्याग और समर्पण की कमी नहीं है। वह देवी बनने के प्रभोभन को ठुकरा देती है। वह चित्तौड़ के लिए अपने व्यक्तिगत जीवन के सुख संतोष और प्रसन्नता को राष्ट्रधर्म पर समर्पित कर देती है। पन्ना का कथन है "सुला दूँगी उसी को। उसी को सुला दूँगी जो मेरी आँखों का तारा है चंदन। चंदन को सुला दूँगी। सामली (सिसकियाँ) चंदन को सुला दूँगी। उस नहें से लाल को हत्यारे की तलवार के नीचे रख दूँगी।' राष्ट्र धर्म को निभान वाला यहाँ कोई अभिजातवर्गीय पात्र नहीं है। पन्ता धाय एक सामान्य सी पात्र है। एकांकीकार इस प्रसंग के माध्यम से यह खापित करना चाहता है कि राष्ट्र की रक्षा में भागीदारी सभी की होनी चाहिए। जहाँ यह भाव नहीं होता है, वहाँ समाज और जीवन सुरक्षित नहीं होते हैं।

#### 17.3 चरित्र

किसी भी एकांकी का ढाँचा कथानक, चिरत्र और घटना की एक सूत्रता से निर्मित होता है। ये तीनों तत्व अलग—अलग नहीं होकर एकांकी के विन्यास में समाहित होते हैं। कथावस्तु से यह स्पष्ट ही है कि सारे पात्र ऐतिहासिक हैं। इसलिए कुछ पात्र तो इतिहास के द्वारा निश्चित कर दिए गए हैं। परंतु कुछ को एकांकीकार ने अपनी दृष्टि की नवीनता से रचा है। ऐतिहासिक एकांकी में कल्पना और इतिहास का तनावपूर्ण समीकरण उभरता है। कथा और घटना इतिहास पर आधारित होने के कारण मुख्य पात्र का चारित्रिक गठन सुनिश्चित होता है। एकांकीकार उसके मनोविज्ञान, भाव और द्वंद्व से उसमें नवीनता देता है। जिससे एकांकी का प्रभाव संक्षिप्त सचन और तीव्र हो पाता है। वर्मा जी की विशेषता रही है कि कथ्य के अनुरूप चरित्र की रूपरेखा को सजाते सँवारते हैं। अनावश्यक विस्तार, प्रस्तुति में नाटय प्रभाव को खंडित कर सकता है।

#### 17.3.1 मुख्य पात्र

#### 1. पन्ना धाय

दीपदान एकांकी के पात्रों का चारित्रिक विश्लेषण किया जाए तो उस एकांकी की मुख्य पात्र पन्ना धाय है। पन्ना धाय के त्याग और बिलदान की कहानी जनमानस में रची—बसी है। ऐसे पात्र जिसका एक रूप स्थानीय जन में बसा होता है, उसे मंच पर साकार करना एकांकीकार के लिए चुनौती होता है। इतिहास में पन्ना धाय की छिंव अतीत का हिस्सा है। एकांकी को समकालीन प्रेक्षक के सामने प्रस्तुत करना होता है। इसलिए पन्ना के चरित्र के मनोविज्ञान को नये रूप में प्रस्तुत करके वर्मा जी ने इतिहास को समकालीन वास्तविकता में मूर्त कर दिया है। पन्ना के चरित्र की कुछ विशेषताओं को समझने की जरूरत है। यदि पन्ना के चारित्रिक बुनावट पर नजर डालते हैं तो सबसे पहले उसके जीवन के बाह्य और आंतरिक संघर्ष को समझना अनिवार्य होगा।

#### परिस्थिति के साथ संघर्ष

सबसे पहले पन्ना धाय के जीवन के बाह्य पक्ष को देखा जा सकता है। पन्ना धाय को राज परिवार में चल रही उठा पटक की गहन जानकारी है। असमय दीपदान उत्सव

एक जागीर देना चाहता हूँ। यहाँ तुम्हारे पूजा के लिए तुलजा भवानी का मंदिर बनेगा। मंदिर। सारे लोग तुम्हें उतनी श्रद्धा से देखेंगे कि तुलजा भवानी और तुममें कोई अंतर भी न होगा। तुम्हीं देवी के उस मंदिर में रहोगी। लोग तुम्हारी पूजा करेंगे।" बनवीर चित्तौड़ के सिंहासन से उसे देवी—बनाने का निमंत्रण देता है। लेकिन पन्ना को देवी बनना भी स्वीकार्य नहीं। वह कुँवर उदय सिंह के प्रति निष्ठावान है। यही निष्ठा उसके चरित्र को विराट और उच्च बनाता है।

#### परंपरा के प्रति विश्वास

पन्ना धाय में अपने देश राष्ट्र की परंपरा के प्रति गहरा विश्वास है। वित्तौड़ के इतिहास की वह बार—बार स्मरण ही नहीं करती है, दूसरे पात्रों को भी उस इतिहास की याद दिलाती है। सबसे पहले तो वह उदय सिंह से कहती है "अभी समय नहीं आया कुँअर चित्तौड़ की रक्षा में तुम्हें तलवार के साथ सोना पड़ेगा।" राजपूत किस तरह बिलदान देकर अपने मर्यादा की रक्षा करता है। चित्तौड़ उसका गवाह है। उस गौरवशाली परंपरा हिस्सा होना पन्ना लिए जीवन की सबसे बड़ी पूँजी है। जीवन के किठन क्षण में भी उसी के सहारे विजय प्राप्त करती है। परंपरा में उसका विश्वास वंश परंपरा के प्रति भी है और वहाँ के सिंहासन की मर्यादा के लिए भी है। वह सामली से कहती है "कुँअर जी की रक्षा (खींचते हुए) कुँअर जी की रक्षा अवश्य होगी। अब मेवाड़ का उत्तराधिकारी एक यही तो राजपूत रक्त है। दासी पुत्र बनवीर को चित्तौड़ सहन नहीं कर सकेगा।"

#### निडर और साहसी व्यक्तित्व

पन्ना धाय विपरीत परिस्थिति होने पर भी साहस नहीं खोती। वह मध्यकालीन इतिहास में उन गिने—चुने स्त्री पात्रों में है जिसके साहस और जोखिम की कहानी लोगों के लिए आदर्श है। उसके हिम्मत की परीक्षा तब होती है जब महल में अकेली है। उसके सामने तलवार लेकर अधिकार मद में पागल होकर बनवीर सामने आता है। पन्ना यह जानती है कि बनवीर उसकी जान ले सकता है, उसकी हत्या की जा सकती है। परंतु वह बनवीर के सामने कमजोर नहीं पड़ती है। निर्भयता से उसे नीच पापी नराधम तक कहती है। वह बनवीर पर आक्रमण करते हुए कहती है "नहीं ऐसा नहीं होगा। क्रूर नराधम नारकी। ले मेरी कटार का प्रसाद ले (आक्रमण करती है, उसकी चोट बनवीर की विवार नहीं करती है। बनवीर उसकी जीभ काटने की धमकी देता है। पन्ना उससे कह देती है "तो लो मेरी जीम काट लो। और यहाँ से चले जाओ।"

#### आंतरिक व्यथा और पीड़ा

एकांकी के आरंभ में उसका वात्सल्य भाव कुँवर उदय सिंह के प्रति है। धाय माँ है लेकिन उदय सिंह के लिए अपनी माँ से भी बढ़कर है। अपनी ममता और रनेह से उन्हें सींचती है। उनकी एक—एक बाल सुलभ गतिविधि पर पैनी दृष्टि रखती है। बालक के हठ को भी वह उसकी सुरक्षा के लिए नजरअंदाज कर देती है। जब उदय सिंह नाच देखने का हठ करते है तो उन्हें जाने से मना कर देती है। उनकी भोजन से लेकर शैय्या तक की वह देखभाल करती है। पन्ना के जीवन में नाटक यह है कि जितना वह उदय सिंह रनेह रखती है उतना ही उसे अपने पुत्र की भी चिंता है। चंदन उसका अपना पुत्र है। चंदन और उदय सिंह दोनों बालक हैं। दोनों की चंचलता से पन्ना का मातृत्व सुखी और संतुष्ट होता है। एकांकी में वह ऐसे मोड़ पर खड़ी है जहाँ एक का बिलदान उसे करना पड़ेगा। उससे उसका हृदय दूट जाता है। एक तरफ राज परिवार के प्रति स्वामिभिक्त दूसरी तरफ अपने पुत्र का मोह। पन्ना के लिए यह चुनाव अत्यंत कठिन है। भीतर से उसका हृदय कराह उठता है। उसकी इस पीड़ा और वेदना को उसी के शब्दों में अनुभव किया जा सकता है। पन्ना कहती है 'चंदन मेरा लाल सो

#### क्रूर और महत्वाकांक्षी

बनवीर क्रूर है। उसकी क्रूरता महत्वाकांक्षा से प्रेरित है। राज सत्ता के लोभ में वह कुँवर सिंह उदय बड़े भाई महाराणा विक्रमादित्य की हत्या कर देता है। उसका कोई अफसोस अपितु इसे नहीं है। उसे वह अपनी वीरता समझ रहा है। पन्ना से वह कहता है "वे अब इस संसार में नहीं हैं पन्ना। उन्होंने रक्त को नदी पार कर ली है। उसी रक्त की लहर मेरे तलवार पर है।" उतने से भी वह चैन नहीं लेता। अब उसे उदय सिंह की तलाश है क्योंकि उसके जीवन का उद्देश्य महाराणा बनना है। उसे महाराणा के रूप में स्वीकृति तब तक नहीं मिलेगी, जब तक उदय सिंह जीवित है। वह किसी भी प्रकार से उदय सिंह हत्या कर अपना मार्ग प्रशस्त करना चाहता है। राजनीति और सत्ता पाने की लोभ में वह क्रूर बन जाता है और उसका चारित्रिक पतन होता है।

#### अविश्वासी और विलासी

बनवीर अविश्वासी पात्र है। उस पर भरोसा नहीं किया जा सकता। बनवीर उदय सिंह का संरक्षक था। उदय सिंह के सुरक्षा की जिम्मेदारी बनवीर की थी। परंतु वह उसके उदय सिंह को विपरीत कार्य करता है। वह अपदस्थ ही करना नहीं चाहता है अपितु उसके प्राणों का प्यासा भी है। पन्ना धाय कहती है "ओह क्रूर बनवीर। तुम तो उदय सिंह के संरक्षक थे। रक्षा के बदले क्या तुम उनकी हत्या करोगे ? नहीं—नहीं यह नहीं हो सकता ? यह नहीं हो सकता महाराणा बनवीर। तुम राज्य करों, चित्तौड़ पर मेवाड़ पर सारे राजपूताने पर राज्य करों पर कुँअर उदय सिंह को छोड़ दो।" अविश्वासी के कारण किस प्रकार का राजनीतिक संकट पैदा हो सकता है उसका जीता जागता उदाहरण बनवीर है। राजनीति विश्वास नीति न्याय और धर्म से बँधी होती है। जब इन मर्यादाओं को तोड़ा जाता है तो ग्रहरा नैतिक संकट पैदा हो सकता है। ऐसा संदेश इस एकांकी के माध्यम से एकांकीकार का है। बनवीर विलासी भी है, सोना को वह रेशमी झूले का उपहार देता है। सोना नृत्यांगना है। दरबार में नृत्यांगना होना उस समय आम बात थी। नृत्यांगना को मनोरंजन के लिए रखा जाता था। बनवीर में राग रंग के प्रति आकर्षण है।

#### 17.3.2 गौण पात्र

दीपदान एकांकी में कुँवर उदय सिंह की अत्यंत छोटी भूमिका है। उत्सव राग और रंग में उनकी रुचि है। बालक होते हुए भी वह अत्यंत साहसी है। पन्ना धाय के पुत्र चंदन में भी बाल सुलभ चंचलता भी दिखाई पड़ती है। गीण पात्र में कीरत बहुत महत्वपूर्ण है। वह पन्ना का विश्वासपात्र है। कीरत में सेवा और स्वामिभवित का भाव है। एकांकीकार उसके चरित्र की नई व्याख्या प्रस्तुत करते हैं। वह जूटन उठाने वाला अवश्य है परंतु चित्त से अत्यंत पवित्र है। वह साहसी है। वह ईमानदार है। अन्नदाता के लिए कोई भी जोखिम उठा सकता है। कीरत के माध्यम से वर्मा जी यह बताना चाहते हैं कि कुल और वंश बड़ा होने से कोई उच्च नहीं होता है अपितु भावना और ईमानदारी से व्यक्ति बड़ा होता है। व्यक्ति, भाव, सोच और कर्तव्य से बड़ा होता है। उसी तरह से दो स्त्री पात्रों सोना और सामली की महती भूमिका है। ये दोनों पात्र दो तरह के जीवनमूल्य का प्रतिनिधित्व करती हैं। सोना का जीवन के प्रति दृष्टिकोण अत्यंत छिछला और उथला है। वह राजसी वैभव से आक्रांत है। सत्ता राग रंग नृत्य मनोरजंन और विलास ही उसका उद्देश्य है। वह पन्ना से कहती है, "दीपकों के साथ उमंगें भी लो देने लगी हैं, धाय माँ! माँ जीवन ही एक दीपावली का त्यौहार बन गया है।" सोना के चरित्र के ठीक विपरीत सामली दासी का चरित्र है। सोना अभिजात्य वर्ग पात्रा है, उसमें वैभव और विलास का आकर्षण है। सामली अन्तःपुर की परिचारिका है। उसमें राजसी ठाट नहीं है। वह महल के भीतर की राजनीति और कूटनीति से परिचित है। अपनी उपस्थिति से घटना की स्थिरता को वह तरंगित कर देती है। बेचैन भाव सी


मंच पर प्रवेश करती है। पन्ना धाय को सूचना देती है कि कुँवर की जान खतरे में है। दूसरी सूचना देती है कि महाराणा विक्रमादित्य की हत्या हो चुकी है। तीसरी सूचना देती है कि संपूर्ण किले को घेर लिया गया है। एकांकीकार ने घटनाओं की सूचना प्रदान करने हेतु सामली की पात्र योजना की है।

#### 17.4 परिवेश

एकांकी नाटक में परिवेश की भूमिका अमूर्त होती है। जिस प्रकार से मिट्टी, हवा, जल आदि से मिलकर हमारा प्राकृतिक परिवेश बनता है, उसी प्रकार इतिहास संस्कृति, राजनीति और धार्मिकता से एकांकी का परिवेश निर्मित होता है। 'दीपदान' का वातावरण सामंती है। इसी मध्ययुगीन इतिहास की पृष्ठभूमि पर एकांकी लिखा गया है। सामंती वैभव दृश्यात्मक रूप से प्रस्तुत करने के लिए एकांकीकार ने कक्ष की सजावट के साथ नृत्य और संगीत की ध्वनि से वातावरण रचना की है। सामंतशाही में नाचगान, मनोरंजन और उत्सव रिवाज़ रहा है। दीपदान के उत्सव के साथ ही एकांकी शुरूआत होती है। तुलजा भवानी की पूजा के लिए कार्यक्रम रखा गया है। इस दीपदान कार्यक्रम में आध्यात्मिकता कम और मनोरंजन ज्यादा है।

'वीपवान' का राजनीतिक परिवेश बिल्कुल मध्यकालीन राजपूती शासन व्यवस्था से संबंधित है। तलवार की ताकत से शासन सुनिश्चित होता था। राजा के अधीन सामंत सरदार उनसे विश्वासघात भी करते थे। अवसर देखकर कोई राजा की हत्या भी कर देता था और शासन पर अधिकार जमा लेता था। बनवीर भी इसी रास्ते से सत्ता को पाना चाहता है। सत्ता की वैधता वंश परंपरा को प्राप्त थी। उसका प्रभाव जनमानस में काफी गहरा था। किसी भी अत्याचारी शासक के खिलाफ विरोध की चिन्गारी अंदर ही अंदर सुलगती रहती थी। राजनीति में अविश्वासी पात्र तो थे ही परंतु वफादार और विश्वासपात्र भी कम नहीं थे। जिनकी निष्ठा, सिंहासन की वंश परंपरा के प्रति होती थी। पन्ता धाय के शब्दों में "मेरे महाराणा का नमक मेरे रक्त से भी महान है। नमक से रक्त बनता रक्त से नमक नहीं।"

समाजिक जीवन में जाति व्यवस्था के प्रचलन की सूचना 'द्वीपदान' एकांकी से मिलती है। उसमें राजपूतों की परंपरा का जिक्र है। 'कीरत बारी' का उल्लेख है सामाजिक जीवन में दास-दासी की प्रथा थी। उसके कारण जटिलताएँ भी पैदा होती थीं। बनवीर महाराणा सांगा के भाई पृथ्वीराज की दासी का पुत्र है। शायद इसी कारण वह सत्ता की दावेदारी रखता है। पन्ना धाय है। तत्कालीन व्यवस्था में अपनी माँ के अभाव में विश्वासी धाय द्वारा राजपुत्रों का लालन-पालन करने का चलन था। राजपुत्र की सेवा और सुरक्षा का संपूर्ण दायित्व उस पर होता था। पन्ना ने धाय की भूमिका ही नहीं निभाई अपितु समय आने पर अपनी परीक्षा भी दी। पन्ना सीधे शब्दों में कहती है "भवानी तुमने मेरे हृदय को कैसा कर दिया? मुझे बल दो कि मैं राजवंश की रक्षा में अपना रक्त दे सकूँ। अपने लाल को दे सकूँ। यह राजपूतनी का व्रत है। यह राजपूतनी की मर्यादा है। यही राजपूती का धर्म है। मेरा हृदय वज्र का बना दो।" राजपूत का धर्म समाज में सुनिश्चित था। समाज और जन की रक्षा के लिए राजपूत अपने प्राण की भी बाजी लगा देते थे। सामाजिक जीवन में और सामंतशाही में नाचने गानेवाली भी होती थी। जो सामंतों के मनोरंजन का साधन होती थी। सोना ऐसी ही चरित्र है। वह नाचकर कुँवर उदय सिंह को आकर्षित करना चाहती है। सोना के लिए रेशमी फूल की व्यवस्था बनवीर करता है। तात्पर्य स्पष्ट है कि ऐश्वर्य का साधन प्रस्तुत करना सामंत की जिम्मेदारी होती थी। उसी तरह महल में सेवा के लिए परिचारिकाएँ भी रखी जाती थीं। वह सेवा के साथ-साथ गुप्तचर का भी कार्य करती थीं। अंतःपुर में होने के कारण उसे महल की सारी गतिविधि का पता होता था। इस प्रकार 'दीपदान' एकांकी के परिवेश में उस





समाज की राजनीति, इतिहास और धार्मिक जीवन की गतिशीलता का अनुभव किया जा सकता है।

#### 17.5 संरचना शिल्प

संरचना शिल्प की दृष्टि से यदि 'दीपदान' का विश्लेषण किया जाए तो यह ऐतिहासिक एकांकी का उदाहरण है। दूसरा इस एकांकी की शैली यथार्थवादी है। यथार्थवादी संरचना होने के साथ—साथ ही उसमें काव्यात्मकता, संक्षिप्तता, सघनता का स्थान—स्थान पर प्रमाण मिलता है। अमूर्त भाव और विचार की टकराहट से दृश्य में गतिशीलता पैदा होती है।

#### 17.5.1 भाषा

'दीपदान' एकांकी की भाषा पर बात करते हुए सबसे पहले शीर्षक पर ही दृष्टि जाती है। शीर्षक में इस एकांकी के सारे सूत्र छिपे हुए हैं। शीर्षक अत्यंत संक्षिप्त, काव्यात्मक और बहुआयामी अर्थ से भरा है। उसमें एक दृश्य बिंब की कल्पना भी साकार हुई है। दीपदान एक उत्सव का प्रतीक है। हर पात्र के लिए उसका अर्थ अलग—अलग है। कुँवर उदय सिंह कुल का दीपक है। भविष्य का प्रकाश है। सोना के लिए यह राजसी उत्सव और त्योहार है। पन्ना धाय के लिए दीपदान, त्याग और मर्यादा की रक्षा है। पन्ना कहती है "आज मैंने भी दीपदान किया है। अपने जीवन का दान। मैंने रक्त की धारा पर तैरा दिया है, ऐसा दीपदान भी किसी ने किया है?" बनवीर के लिए दीपदान उत्सव की ओट में धोखे से सिंहासन पाने के लिए रास्ता दिखाने का प्रतीक है। पात्र और संदर्भ के अनुसार एकाकीकार ने दीपदान दृश्य बिंब को गत्यात्मक अर्थ दिया है। इसी तरह दूटी माला का एक बिंब प्रस्तुत किया गया है। दूटी माला अधूरे और अपूर्ण जीवन का प्रतीक है। चंदन का जीवन ऐसा ही है। वह महल राजनीति की बिल वेदी पर अपना बिलवान करता है। नाहक और एकांकी में शब्द और अभिनय के साथ—साथ दृश्य भाषा की रचना भी अनिवार्य इकाई है। इसलिए भाषा का चित्रात्मक होना जरूरी है। इस एकांकी के संवाद में रपष्ट रूप से इसे देखा जा सकता है यथा—

- वे दीपक छोटे से कुंड में कैसे नाचते हैं?

– मचलते हुए रवर में चलो न धाय माँ।

एकाकी की भाषा में क्रियाकलाप की भाषा पर बल होता है। पात्र की परिस्थिति और मनःस्थिति के अनुकूल उसका गठन होता है। शब्द और भाव का संयोजन में होना आवश्यक है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी की भाषा ठहरी हुई नहीं है। वह पात्र के आक्रोश की पीड़ा, चिंता, उल्लास, घुटन और लाचारी के भाव को नाटकीय अंदाज में दर्शक के सामने प्रस्तुत करने में समर्थ है। प्रसंग के अनुसार भाषा की लय बदलती है। सोना की भाषा काव्यात्मकता भावुकता, कोमलता और आलंकारिक शब्दों से सजी हुई है। उसके एक संवाद को यहाँ उद्धृत किया जा सकता है।

"मेरा पागलपन? धाय माँ पागलपन कहीं कम होता है? पहाड़ चढ़कर कभी छोटे हुए हैं? नदियाँ आगे बढ़कर कभी लौटी हैं? फूल खिलने के बाद कभी कली बने हैं? सब आगे बढ़ते हैं।"

नर्तकी के भाव में जैसा उल्लास है वैसा ही मचलती हुई भाषा उसके संवादों से निकली हैं। पन्ना की भाषा में चिंता, साहस, दूरदर्शिता और योजना की बात है। पन्ना के मानसिक द्वंद्व में करुणा और त्रास है। एक दृश्य में वह गीत गाती है। गीत में विराग है। पुत्र –को सेज पर सुलाती हुई करुण स्वर में गाती है

उड़ जा रे पंखेरुआ साँझ पड़ी।

चार पहन बाटडली जोही। मेडयों खडी एक खडी।

गीत में जीवन के अंत का बयान है। कविता में दर्शन को बयाँ किया गया है। कीरत एकांकी का निम्न वर्ग का पात्र है। उसकी भाषा में राजस्थानी भाषा के स्थानीय शब्द है। लोकभाषा में वह अपनी बात कहता है। उसके भाव में समर्पण और साहस दृष्टिगत होता है। बनवीर की भाषा में घमंड और मदांधता है। अहंकार और आक्रोश के आवेग को उसके संवादों में देखा जा सकता है। चूँिक इस एकांकी की पृष्टभूमि राजस्थानी है। इसलिए वहाँ के लोकजीवन की शब्दावली और मुहावरे का प्रयोग पाठ में सहज ही प्रस्तुत है।

#### 17.5.2 शैली

'दीपदान' एकांकी की संरचना यथार्थवादी नाट्यशिल्प से प्रभावित है। लेकिन साथ-साथ भारतीय नाट्य रूढ़ियों का भी पालन एकांकीकार ने किया है। यथार्थवादी शैली में स्थान, समय और क्रिया के बीच एकान्वति होती है। एकांकी के आरंभ में ही यह सूचित कर दिया गया है। एकांकी का समय 1536 ई है। समय रात्रि का दूसरा प्रहर है और स्थान चित्तौड़ के कुँवर उदय सिंह का कक्ष है। घटना और कथानक के बिखराव से अन्विति का क्रम टूटने न देने के लिए और मंचन में नाट्य प्रभाव तीव्र और संवेगात्मक बनाने के लिए इस शैली का प्रयोग 50 के दशक के एकांकीकारों ने किया है। यथार्थवादी शैली में इस एकांकी की रचना होने के कारण शिल्प सुगठित है। कथाक्रम के विकास, पात्र योजना, संवाद और दृश्य में पर्याप्त संतुलन है। दूसरा, ऐतिहासिक कथावस्तु को आधार बनाने के कारण इस एकांकी का स्वरूप चरित्र प्रधान हों जाता है। जैसा कि एकांकी पढ़ने से जाहिर हो जाता है कि इस एकांकी में पन्ना धाय का चरित्र प्रमुख है। कथानक शैली की दृष्टि से यदि इस एकांकी का मूल्यांकन् किया जाए तो यह दुखान्त शैली का एकांकी है। एकांकी के अंत में पीड़ा और त्रासदी है। महाराज विक्रमादित्य की हत्या की सूचना मिलती है, पन्ना के पुत्र की हत्या होती है, चित्तौड़ का शासन असुरक्षित हो जाता है। त्रासदी के बिन्दु भारतीय शैली के नाटक में नहीं मिलते हैं। यह पश्चिमी नाटक के प्रभाव के रूप में ही समझा जाना चाहिए। पात्र का वध भारतीय नाट्य परंपरा में वर्जित माना गया है। यह एक भारतीय नाट्य रूढ़ि है जिसका पालन इस नाटक में भी करने का प्रयास किया गया है। इस एकांकी में हत्या तो होती है परन्तु मच पर उसे दृश्य के रूप में नहीं रखा गया है।

#### 17.5.3 संवाद

संवाद के माध्यम से ही एकांकी दर्शक तक पहुँचता है। संवाद में एक लय होती है। भावों का उतार चढ़ाव क्रिया—प्रतिक्रिया आवेग और स्वर से उसका निर्माण होता है। प्रस्तुति में वार्तालाप शैली का अधिक उपयोग किया जाता रहा है। संवाद में भाव ध्विन स्वर और मौन छिपा होता है। एकांकी में यह कहीं वार्तालाप के रूप में, कहीं स्वगत के रूप में, कहीं गीत के रूप और कहीं क्रियाकलाप के रूप में सामने आता है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी में पात्र स्थिति के अनुसार संवाद बोलते हैं। यथार्थवादी शैली से प्रेरित होने के कारण इस एकांकी के संवाद में भाषा की बोझिलता नहीं है। अभिनय के लिए वाक्य गठन छोटे हैं और आवेगपूर्ण हैं। पन्ना के संवाद हैं 'अबोध सोते हुए बालक पर हाथ उठाते हुए तेरा हृदय तुझे नहीं धिक्कारता ? पापी।'' स्वगत में पात्र अपने आप से बात करता है। पात्र के अंतर्मन में उठने वाले भाव की वेदना और आनंद स्वयं ही अनुभव करता है। पन्ना का कथन है— ''तुमने मेरे हृदय को कैसा कर दिया। मुझे बल दो कि मैं राजवंश की रक्षा में अपना रक्त दे सकूँ। अपने लाल को दे सकूँ।'' इस एकांकी में एक दो सवाद स्वगत में है जो मन को मथने वाले हैं।



संवाद में प्रवाह का होना आवश्यक है। प्रवाह का टूटना और अवरुद्ध होना दर्शक में नाट्य प्रभाव को खंडित करता है। स्वाभाविक संवाद में और अधिक अभिनय की संभावना होनी चाहिए। 'दीपदान' एकांकी में एक दो स्थल पर संवाद का प्रवाह टूटता सा मालूम पड़ता है। सोना और पन्ना के संवाद में उपदेशात्मकता अधिक है और नाटकीयता का अभाव मिलता है। इसी तरह से कहीं—कहीं पुनरावृति भी हुई है। कुँवर उदय सिंह और बनवीर दोनों चित्तौड़ की तलवार की प्रशंसा करते हैं। उसमें संदर्भ का अंतर स्पष्ट नहीं हो पाता है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी के संवाद में कार्यकलाप की भाषा की अपेक्षा वाच्य भाषा पर अधिक बल दिया है।

#### 17.6 रंगमंचीयता

नाटक अथवा एकांकी रचना की अनिवार्यता उसकी रंगमंचीयता है। रंगमंचीय व्याख्या के बिना एकांकी का पाठ पूरा नहीं होता है। 'दीपदान' एकांकी यथार्थवादी शैली का उदाहरण है। इसे सीमित साधन में छोटे अभिनेता समूह के द्वारा छोटे प्रेक्षागृह में मंचित किया जा सकता है। इसे कार्यक्रम में भी प्रस्तुत किया जा सकता है। इस एकांकी की रंग परिकल्पना में अभिनय, दृश्य रचना, प्रकाश, रूप, सज्जा, वेशभूषा, ध्वनि, और संगीत के घटक जुड़े हुए हैं। चार पुरुष पात्र और तीन स्त्री पात्र अभिनय के लिए रखे गए हैं। उम्र वर्ग आयु के हिसाब से अभिनेता—अभिनेत्री को स्पष्ट कर दिया गया है। दृश्य रचना में स्थान और उसकी पृष्ठभूमि को स्पष्ट कर दिया गया है। एकांकी के आरंभिक रंग संकेत में ही पृष्टभूमि को स्पष्ट कर दिया गया है। एकांकीकार ने लिखा हैं- "कक्ष में पूरी सजावट हैं, दरवाजे पर रेशमी पर्दे हैं। पास में उदय सिंह की शय्या है सिरहाने पन्ना के बैठने का स्थान है।" दृश्य रचना के साथ-साथ ध्वनि और संगीत का कल्पनाशील उपयोग किया गया है। यहाँ कोई भी निर्देशक अपने हिसाब से मचन करने की प्रक्रिया में नृत्य संगीत और ध्वनि का रचनात्मक उपयोग कर सकता है। दृश्य सज्जा के लिए एकांकीकार ने पूर्वे शैय्या आदि को बता दिया है। कक्ष में प्रस्तुति योजना के मुताबिक एकांकी में दृश्य रचना की गई है। वस्त्र सज्जा में राजपूती परिधान के साथ आभूषण नुपूर आदि को रखा गया है। प्रकाश सज्जो की व्यवस्था को दृश्य के अनुसार रखा जा सकता है।

एकांकी में पात्र प्रवेश और प्रस्थान की स्पष्ट सूचना दी गई है। कोष्ठक में प्रवेश और प्रस्थान के रंग संकेत को देखा जा सकता है। विशिष्टताओं के अनुसार प्रवेश रखे गए हैं। सोना का प्रवेश नुपूर की नाद करते हुए है। सामली चीख पुकारती हुई प्रवेश करती है। दृश्य में दो से अधिक पात्र का संभाषण नहीं है। निर्देशक अपनी कल्पना के अनुसार मंचन को जश्न भी बना सकता है और सादगी में भी प्रस्तुत कर सकता है। उसकी गुंजाइश पाठ में लेखक द्वारा रखी गई है। अभिनय द्वारा इस एकांकी को मंचित किया जा सकता है। यथार्थवादी कहने का अर्थ है कि रोजमर्रा के जीवन में हम जिस प्रकार कार्यकलाप करते हैं जिस तरह से बोलते हैं और भावावेग को प्रकट करते हैं उसी तरह के पैटर्न में इस एकांकी के संवाद, संभाषण, स्वगत और वार्तालाप को प्रस्तुत किया जा सकता है उसके लिए किसी विशेष प्रशिक्षण की आवश्यकता नहीं है। पन्ना धाय के चरित्र के अभिनय में थोड़ी संभावना है। मावों की जटिलता और द्वंद्वात्मक मनोभाव में पात्रों के अभिनय का कौशल खिलता है। बाकी के पात्रों के चरित्र का ग्राफ सरल और सीधा है।

#### 17.7 सारांश
