1. Webinar on "Selective Dissemination of Information Services to Library Users using Print and Open Access Sources" - November 12th, 2021.

On the 12th of November 2021, the College Library hosted a webinar titled "Selective Dissemination of Information Services to Library Users using Print and Open Access Sources" through the Google Meet platform. This webinar aimed to enhance the knowledge and skills of library professionals and users regarding the effective utilization of print and open access resources for disseminating information.

1. Transition to Koha Software

In pursuit of upgrading library services and facilities, as well as making library resources accessible online and remotely, the College Library transitioned from its previous software (NETTLIB) to the Koha Integrated Library Management System.

2. Introduction of Integrated Library Management System (KOHA)

The College Library has embraced the modern era of library management through the implementation of the Integrated Library Management System known as KOHA. This open-source software operates on a cloud server, providing a dynamic and efficient solution for library automation.

Koha, derived from the Māori word "gift," represents the world's pioneering open-source library automation system. Developed by the Horowhenua Library Trust in 1999, Koha was

3. Procedure for Operating Integrated Library Management System (KOHA) on Cloud Server.

The College Library has streamlined its operations through the utilization of KOHA's cloud-based Integrated Library Management System.

The following are the key functionalities of KOHA:

- WEB OPAC: Patrons can access comprehensive information about the library's collection, facilities, and services through the library's website. Two OPAC terminals, located on the ground floor, and one on the first floor, facilitate online searches for library publications.
- Remote Accessibility: Library resources, services, and facilities are accessible remotely, allowing patrons to conveniently check the availability, accessibility, and location of resources by various criteria, including Title, Author, Subject, Publisher, and Keywords.

Patron Account Access: Patrons can access their library membership accounts using a Login ID and Password. The Login ID is the Member ID Number, and the initial Password is provided on the college ID card. Patrons can change their password for added security. Within their accounts, patrons can review book transaction records, fine charges, personal details, checkout history, and more, all from a remote location.






