



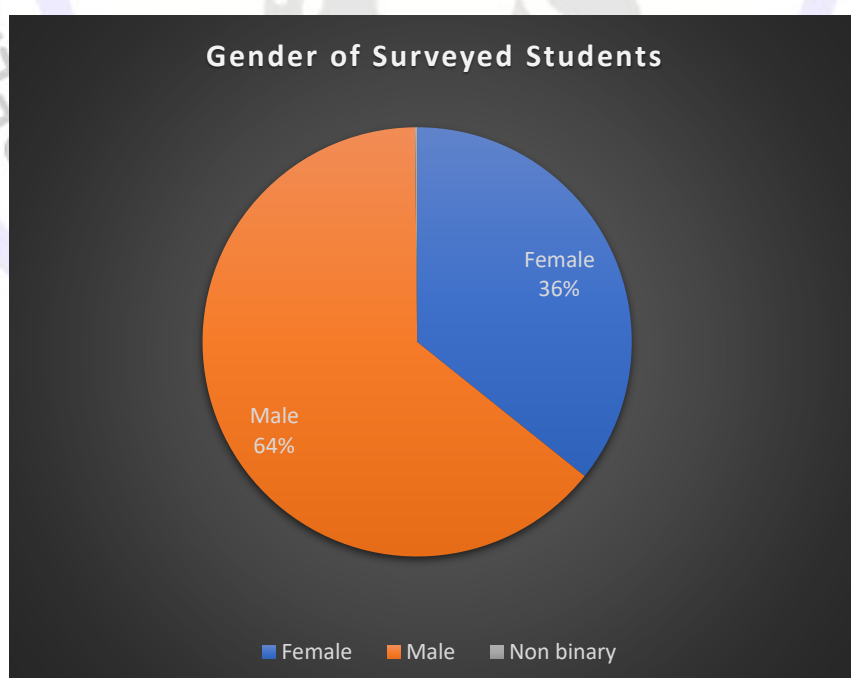
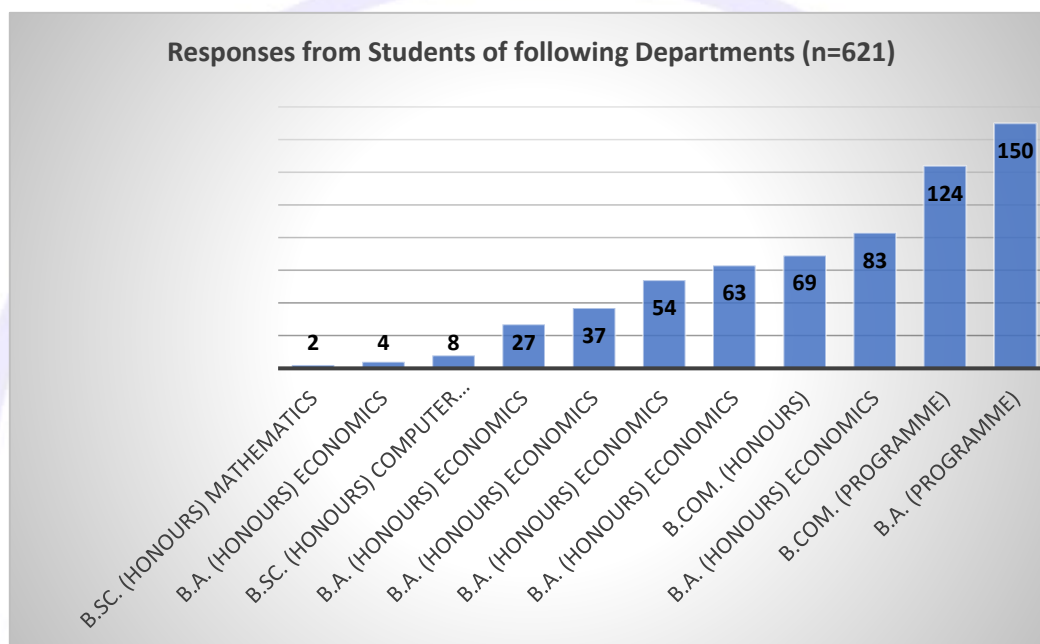
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Summary of Students' Feedback 2021-22

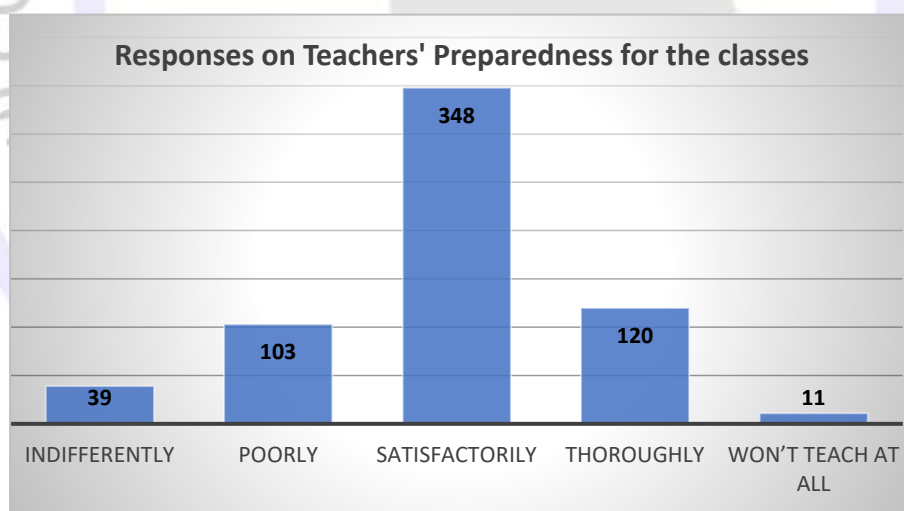
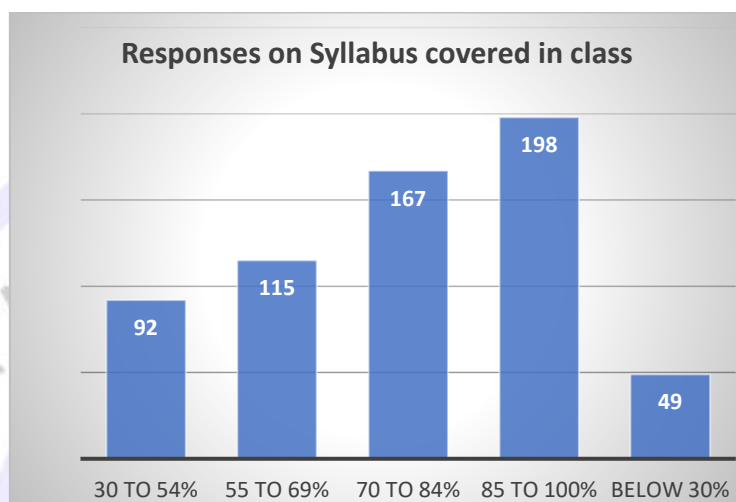


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Responses regarding Teaching-Learning Process and Environment

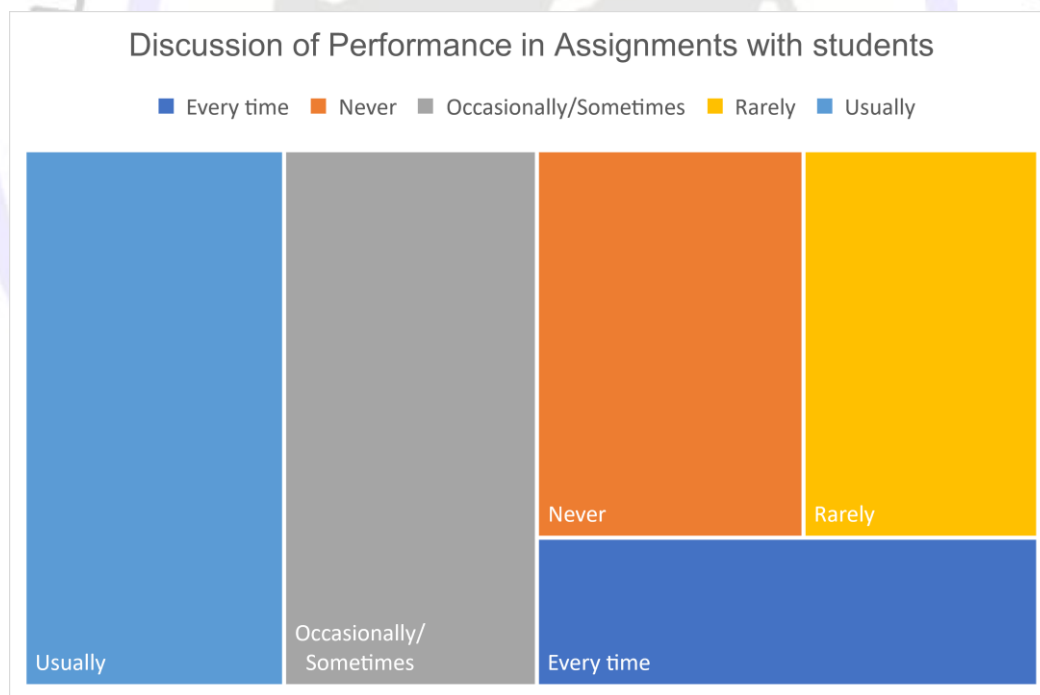
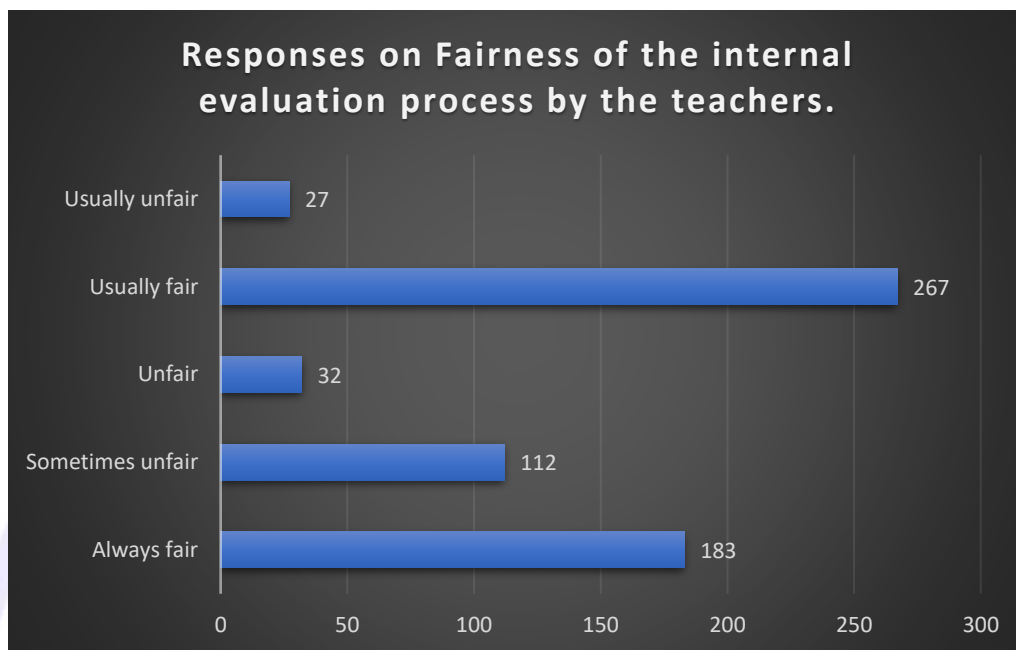




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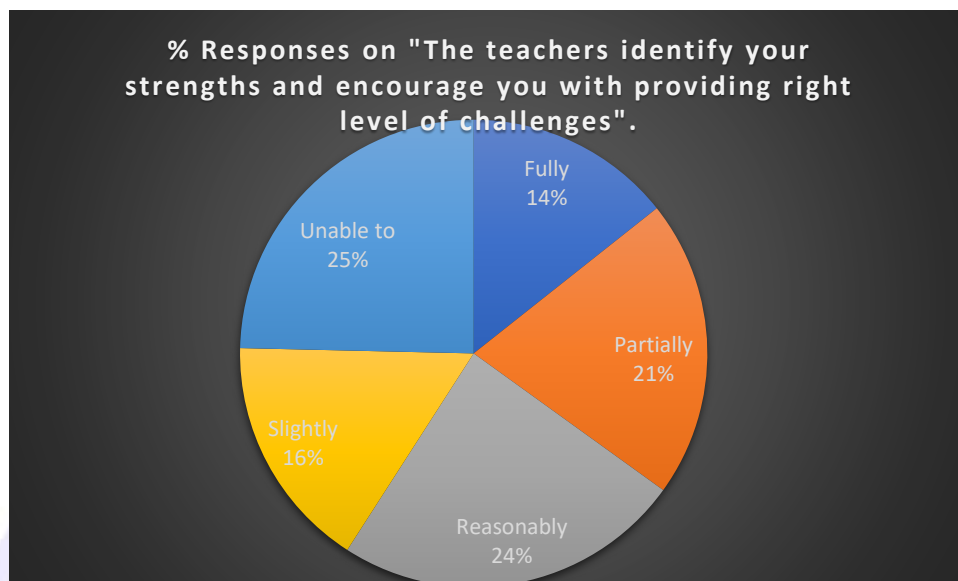

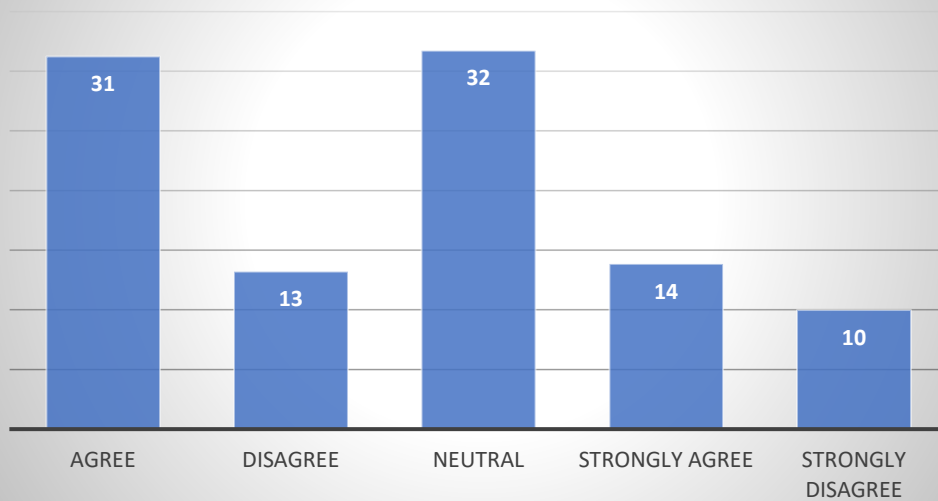


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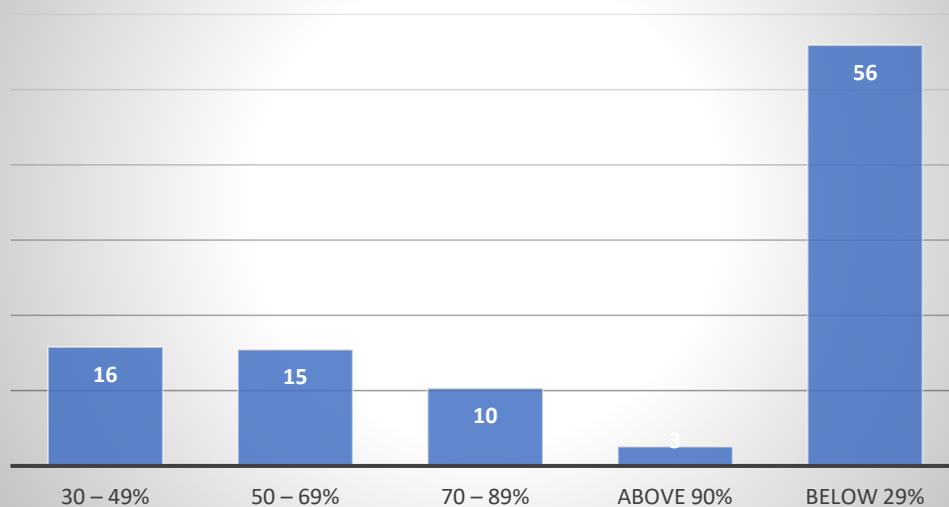
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% Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.



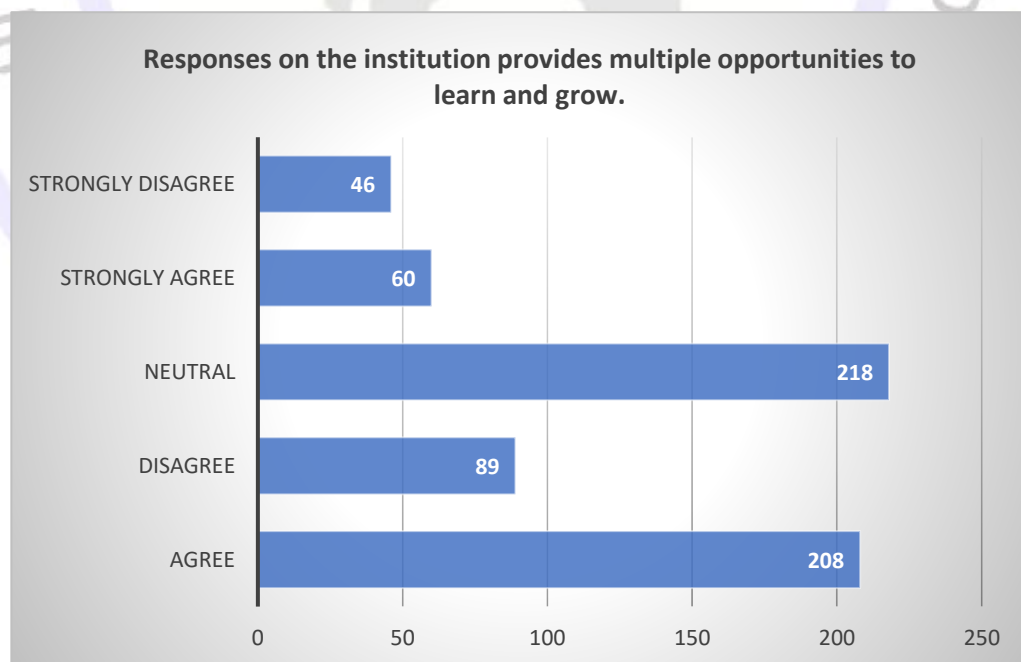
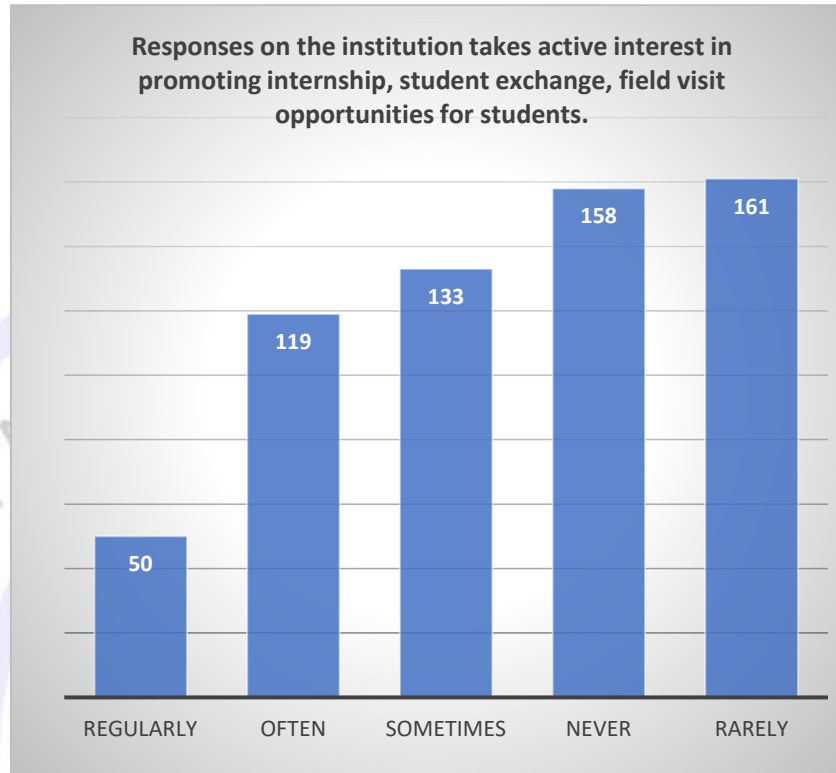

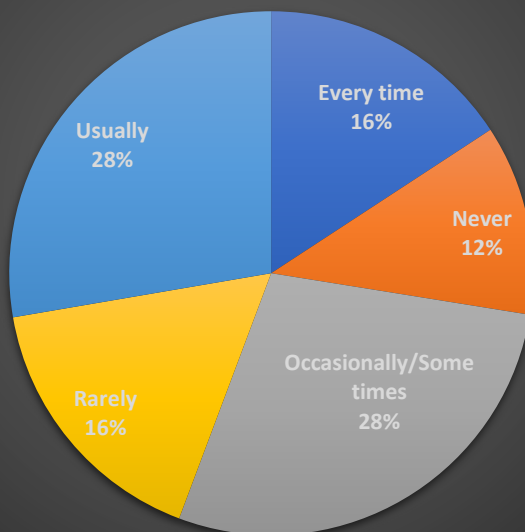


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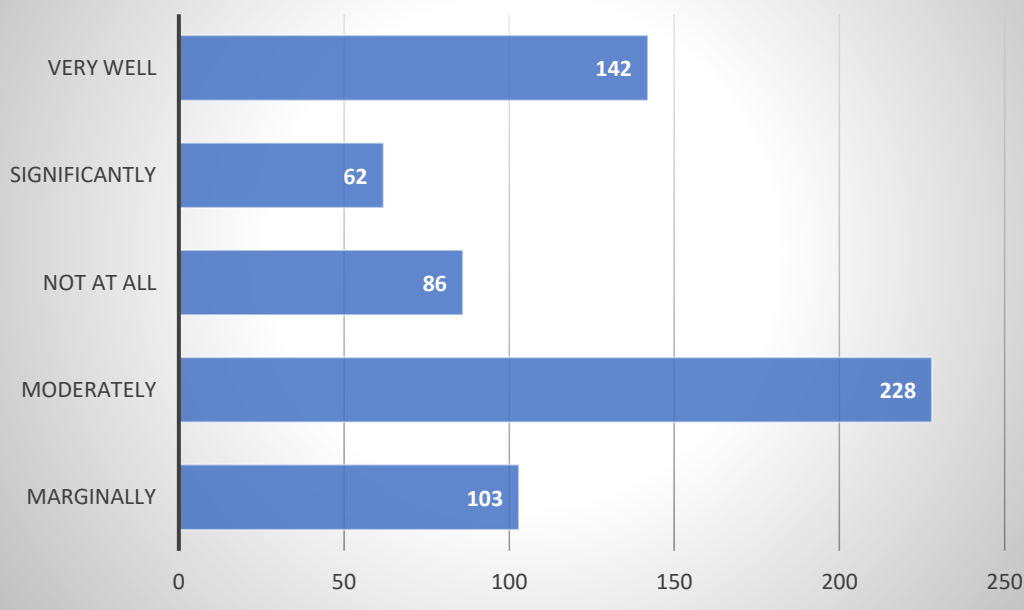
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MENTORING ROLE
