


Hidden in Plain Sight- Muralidhar Devidas Amte by Yogeshwar Paswan

Foreign Direct Investment Inflow and Its Effect on Economy of India

Dr. Neeraj & Neha Agarwal

Abstract

Indian economy is currently part of the 100 club on Ease of Doing Business and this is done for the country economic development by the way of attracting more overseas funds and this strategy is playing an important role in the encouragement of foreign and overseas investors. Since 2014, it has emerged as of the one top foreign destination in the world with a significant rise in FDI. The purpose of this paper is to examine the Total Inflow of FDI in India in form of equity and it also determines top investor Countries in India. The Paper also aims to look at different aspects of FDI (positive and negative effect of FDI in the process of economic growth and social welfare in developing countries like India) spill over in the country. This paper is based upon secondary data analysis of the inflow of FDI in India during the period 2000-2018; the study shows the trends in the aggregate inflow of FDI in India during 2000-2001 and 2017-18. This paper concludes that share of FDI from Singapore is highest (37.77%) during 2018-19 and after refinement of investment policy Indian economy received the maximum FDI (Rs. 291,696 crores) during 2016-17. Paper also highlights that biggest beneficiary of this would be small farmers, who would be able to improve productivity and realize higher remuneration by selling directly to large organized players and shorten the chain from farm to consumers. In fact, FDI provides a win – win situation to the host and the home countries if government policy supports the required infrastructure and favourable conditions for investors by controlling bad cholesterol.

India has been the largest recipient of FDI for more than three and a half decades. India is the largest recipient of FDI during 2006 with an investment of 184 billion dollars from OECD (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development) countries. France, Greece, Iceland, Poland, Slovak Republic, Switzerland and Turkey also have a positive record in FDI investments. As per UNCTAD's World Investment Report 2019, Global foreign direct investment (FDI) flows slid by 13% in 2018, to US\$ 1.3 trillion from \$1.5 trillion the previous

year-the third consecutive annual decline. Despite the FDI decline, the United States remained the largest recipient of FDI, followed by China, Hong-Kong and Singapore during 2018-19. In terms of outward investors, Japan became the largest followed by China and France. Singh et.al (2012) explains that one of the significant contributions of globalization in the past is the growing and spreading FDI amongst the countries, contributing significantly to positive effects on the labour productivity of domestic firms. The Industrial policy 1991 had crafted a trajectory of change whereby every sectors of Indian economy at one point of time or the other would be embraced by liberalization, privatization and globalization due to that foreign investment have been flowing into the economy. In 1997, FDI in cash and carry (wholesale) with 100 percent ownership was allowed under the Government approval route. It was brought under the automatic route in 2006. The Indian economy is currently part of the 100 club on Ease of Doing Business and globally ranked first in Greenfield FDI ranking. Iqbal (2007) point out that India has emerged as major recipient of FDI in South Asia. It is a resourceful country having an adequate market for both capital and consumer goods. As per Singh (2009) large amount of natural resources in the country as well as excellent market surroundings provide a platform for investments. Gori (2015) explains that the liberalization phase in Indian economy has paid rich dividends to the country. Foreign countries are eager to invest in India in order to take advantage of lower wages, tax exemption etc. This has generated employment and has helped the economy in upgrading the higher and better technology. A favourable investor friendly policy regime with robust business environment has ensured regular and smoother flow of foreign flow into the country. Heckscher-Ohlin-Samuelson model suggests that FDI and international trade can be substitutes under assumption that labour and capital can move freely between countries and no transportation cost apply. This suggests for indirect linkage between international trade and exchange production factor between the two as explained by Liu (2002). Most of the emerging economies and those in transition phase view FDI as an important source of financing.

So, from the above facts it is clear that Investment, or creation of capital, is an essential component of economic growth of a country. In general, the investment may lead to the creation of physical capital goods, finance, and human capital. In grouping with other factors of production and technology, investment determines the levels and growth through changes in production in production and consumption of goods and services. Investments consist of foreign investment and domestic investment. Foreign Investment basically includes two spectrums - funds and technological

October 14-17, 2020: Workshop- From Data to Insights

From data to Insights: A hands-on training program was conducted by **Ecolibrium: The Economics Department of DCAC** from 14th October to 17th October 2020. The workshop was focused on data visualization using Excel and Latex (an open source effective documentation software).



The course was divided into four modules each of which taught by the following faculty members: Dr. Arun Kumar, Dr. Shalini Saksena, Dr. Navneet Manchanda and Dr. Bir Singh.

Students were exposed to various free institutional data repositories like RBI, MoSPI, WDI etc. They were taught how to extract and clean the data in Excel. Students got their hands-on real-time visualization of cross-sectional data and temporal visualizations with spreadsheets. After each module students were given individual assignments to track their progress. In the last module, students were introduced to Latex, an effective tool for documentation, where they had to compile all the learnings of the previous modules and prepare a report on, "A Comparative Study of South Asian Economies: Focused on differences in Healthcare outcomes of India and Bangladesh". They had to evaluate India's performance across various development and economic indicators vis-a-vis her neighbours using data from World Development Indicators. 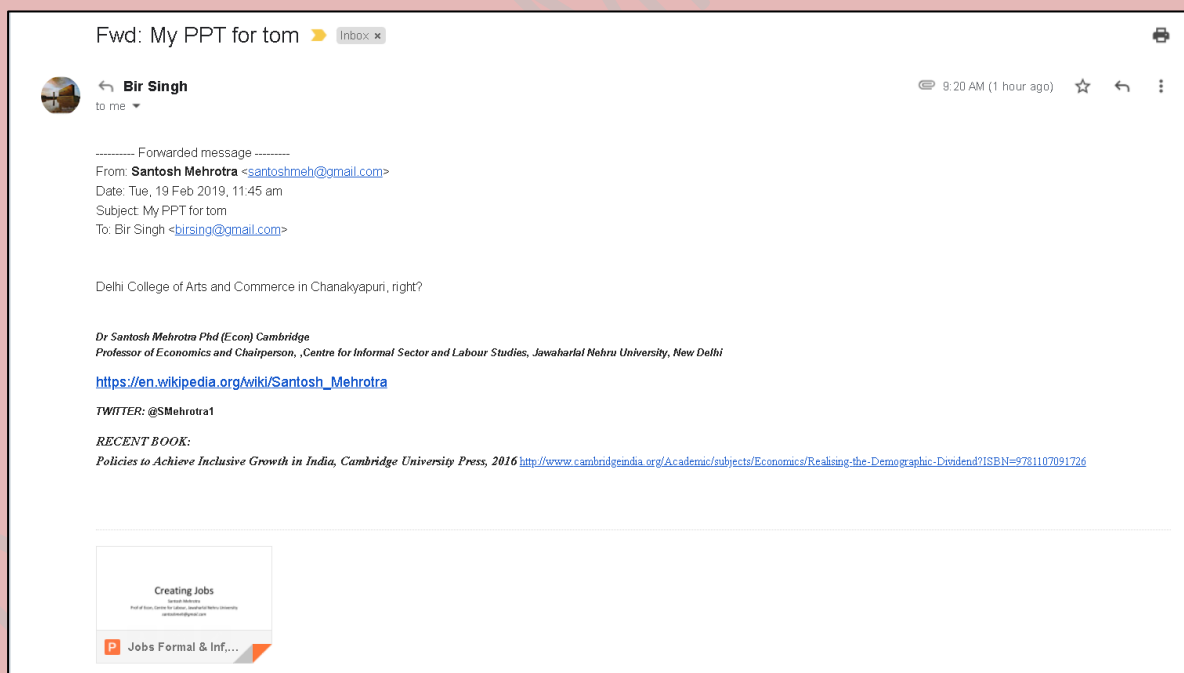



Prof. Ghosh has a PhD in Economics from MIT and has taught for 8 years at Haverford college, Philadelphia. His expertise is in macroeconomics and international economics and he has published extensively in peer reviewed journals. At Haverford, he has taught courses in macroeconomics, money and banking, international macroeconomics, computational economics, and financial crises. As a scholar, he is also deeply interested in questions of an interdisciplinary nature, at the intersections of economics and other disciplines such as sociology, anthropology, political science, philosophy and religion.

The Rationale of Irrational Behaviour

Do economic agents satisfy or maximize?



Talk by Prof. Shagata Mukherjee

TOPIC: Is rationality more logical or psychological? What is the rationale behind irrational economic behaviour? These are some of the fundamental questions that Prof. Mukherjee explores in this talk. The Classical school of economic thought excludes cognitive, psychological and social factors while analyzing economic behaviour. This lecture explains the rationale behind irrationality, hereby introducing the **Behavioural Economics** school of thought. It first goes on to explore observed key departures from Classical economic theories, thereby substantiating the need for Behavioural Economics, while tracing the historical development of the field. Finally, it explores the applicability of Behavioural Economics as a 'nudge', both, explaining and influencing decision making, with the aid of examples. The session will be interactive where students will participate in behavioural games that will help them to have a deeper understanding of the subject.

Speaker: Prof. Mukherjee is a graduate of Presidency College, Kolkata and JNU, Delhi. He completed his PhD at Georgia State University's Andrew Young School of Policy Studies in Atlanta, USA. His research interests are in the fields of development economics, behavioral and experimental economics and public policy. His work has a strong focus on the role of gender, social contexts and norms on policies. Using empirical analysis and experimental methods, he attempts to answer real-world policy-relevant questions such as 'how to reduce the risk of default among microfinance borrowers,' and 'how to increase community participation to provide local public goods'.

PANTHEON 2019:

The annual ELA festival, PANTHEON was held on 7th February, 2019. The theme of the festival this year was NEW CANONS: READING POPULAR LITERATURE. Professor Sumanyu Sathpathy, retired Professor & Head, Department of English, University of Delhi gave the Keynote address. His insightful lecture threw light on the 'low-brow' tag assigned to popular literature in today's time. Citing examples from Elizabethan era to the modern time, Professor Sathpathy brought out why popular literature has always existed and should continue to do so. The festival had a number of events like Nukkad Natak, dance, street football, slam poetry, paper presentation and much more.

ELA launched its book and film club on 27th February, 2019. The club gives a platform to students across departments to discuss various aspects of a book or a film screened. An intense discussion followed the first screening of the 1950 classic, CITIZEN KANE.

WORKSHOP ON GENDER, FORM AND IDENTITY:

Mr. Aruni Mahapatra, Ph. D scholar at Emory University conducted a workshop on gender and identity on 11th March, 2019. He interacted with students and the workshop included a close reading of poems by female poets across the globe such as Kamala Das.

STUDENTS' CONFERENCE ON WOMEN'S WRITING:

A one-day students' conference was organised on the topic **READING WOMEN, WRITING WOMEN: TOWARDS A LITERATURE OF THEIR OWN** on 13th march, 2019.

Padmashree awardee and founder of Zubaan Publishings, Ms. Urvashi Butalia was the keynote speaker. The address was followed by 4 Sessions of Paper Presentations where students from across university of Delhi participated and made presentations.



TALK ON DALIT LITERATURE:

ELA organised a talk on Dalit literature on 09th April, 2019. Professor Rajkumar, Head, Department of English, University of Delhi, was the keynote speaker and addressed the students on the topic “Dalit Literature: Text & Context”. The department also launched the second edition of the newsletter, The Carrel exclusively devoted to the topic. Students made paper presentations on the theme of exclusions and marginalisations. This event was held in collaboration with the IQAC cell.

BOOK AND FILM CLUB:

• Seminars and Talks

• ‘The Truth of Literature at the Present Time’ with Professor Jyotirmaya Tripathy Professor Jyotirmaya Tripathy gave a talk on August 16, 2019 on the various issues regarding accountability of what is termed as ‘Literature’ and escapist fiction entitled ‘The Truth of Literature at the Present Time’.

• ‘The Task of a Translator’ with Arunava Sinha (famous writer and translator) An interactive seminar was organised on September 26, 2019 to discuss the challenges faced by translators in today’s time. The guest speaker was Arunava Sinha who translates modern Bengali fiction and nonfiction into the English language.

• ‘Modernism: A Synoptic Genealogy’ with Sumanyu Satpathy, former Professor, Department of English, University of Delhi A seminar was organised on Modernism on November 4, 2019, tracing the development and the seminal texts of the 20th century movement. The speaker was Professor Sumanyu Satpathy who is a visiting Professor at the Department of English, Jamia Millia Islamia, Delhi.

• ‘British Literature of the 18th Century’ with Shaswat Panda, Assistant Professor, University of Keonjhar, Orissa A talk was organised on January 31, 2020 on 18th Century Literature. The speaker, Sashwat Panda, helped the students place the literature of this era into its sociopolitical context by developing on the major events of the century and their impact on the writings that were produced. • Movie Screenings

• Singin’ in the Rain The Book and Film Club held its first movie screening of Singin’ in the Rain, directed by Gene Kelly and Stanley Donen, and starring Kelly, Donald O’Connor, Debbie Reynolds, on August 9, 2019. The session began with an introductioncum-history of the Musical genre by our faculty Dr Smita Banerjee and ended with a lively discussion of the technical aspects of the film.

• Life is Beautiful The Club organised the screening of Life is Beautiful, directed by Roberto Benigni and starring Benigni & Nicoletta Braschi, on August 23, 2019. The discussion began with an overview of the works by the director, followed by an active discussion on the technical aspects of the movies, the Holocaust and related literature.

• Fandry A screening-cum-discussion of Fandry, directed by Nagraj Manjule, starring Somnath Avghade and Rajeshwari Kharat, was held on September 17, 2019. This was followed by a discussion on the interplaying dynamics of caste and gender in India.

• Book Club Meet Events

• A discussion on Alice Walker’s The Color Purple was held on November 13, 2019 . The session was moderated by faculty members who helped the students critically analyse the different themes of this significant text.

• A discussion around Mahasweta Devi’s collection of short stories titled Breast Stories, in celebration of the Women in Translation Month, was organised on September 6, 2019. The writings were translated by the famous postcolonial and feminist intellectual and critic Gayatri Chakravorty Spivak.

- An interactive session with Amitabha Bagchi, famous writer, was held on February 4, 2020 who discussed at length his latest book *Half the Night is Gone*. The novel is this year's DSC prize winner. The writer also talked about the reception of the novel and the criticism that it invited.

- Online Events

- Women in Translation Month Celebration on Instagram The department celebrated Women in Translation Month all through the month of August, 2019 to bring light to the various women translators who are regularly overlooked by the mainstream academia. Many members contributed to this online celebration by submitting self-translated poems and short stories.
- Online Photography Competition Photographers from various colleges of the university participated in the online photography competition held on January 4, 2020 via Instagram. The images were judged on the basis of the number of likes they received. Winners were declared a week later and certificates were furnished to all participants.

- Freshers' Party and Orientation A welcome party was organised for the batch of 2022 on August 26, 2019. The theme was 'I Can't Believe I Wore That!'

- Poetry Reading Session with Akhil Katyal (renowned poet) A poetry reading session was organised on September 9, 2019. The guest poet invited was Akhil Katyal who is a bilingual Delhi-based poet navigating through themes such as Kashmir, Partition, class, caste, queerness in his poetry. He read from his latest collection *How Many Countries Does the Indus Cross*. After his performance, members of the department also recited some of their own poems which were highly appreciated by the audience of young budding poets.

- The Carrel: launch of the third edition: The third edition of the biannual newsletter of the department, *The Carrel*, was launched on November 4, 2019. This edition invited an exploration of a diverse array of retellings of history and mythology, with a special emphasis on interviews that help us learn about the way such writers approach these retellings and what do they think about the 29 society's fascination with myths. Featuring answers from the likes of Ashwin Sanghi, Sharanya Manivannan, Devdutt Pattanaik and Pooja Sharma, the newsletter also reviewed books that attempt to retell mythology, as well as offered insights into the importance of history and mythology in our lives. Characters like Draupadi, Helen, Medea and various others were brought back into the spotlight, erasing margins. From pop culture to politics, from feminist to subaltern studies, from prose to poetry – this edition of *The Carrel* was a kaleidoscope of fresh ideas. The launch was attended by the students, faculty members, the principal and Professor Sumanyu Satpathy.

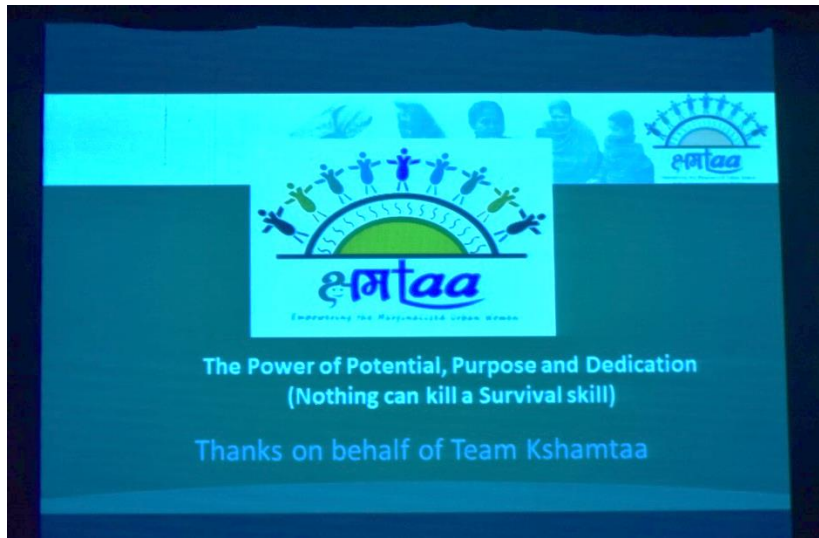

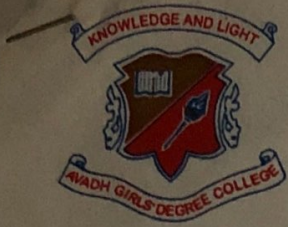
